

Guitar Courses

Guitar Class (MUS 162T)

Class instruction for the beginning guitarist is set up to give students with little or no guitar experience the opportunity to learn how to play proficiently on their instrument. Reading music, learning a variety of right hand styles, developing a foundational chord vocabulary, and introducing styles ranging from folk to rock and classical to jazz will provide a well-rounded and interesting first approach to the guitar.

Guitar Ensemble (MUS 151/2T – 251/2T)

Guitar Ensemble is set up to introduce and expose students to the practice and performance of chamber music. Students will exercise their ability to perform and communicate quality music written or transcribed for any combination of guitar ensemble. Additionally, this course supplies sufficient performing opportunities whether departmental, college-wide, or in the community.

Guitar Repertory (MUS 121/2T – 221/2T)

A musical performance should be judged by how well a performer communicates his/her feelings and ideas about a piece of music to the audience. In order to do this a musician must have complete technical control over the mental and physical aspects of their chosen instrument. Through weekly performance opportunities and critical reviews from peers and faculty, Guitar Repertory will teach all guitar students at Onondaga Community College how much they communicate through a performance and to equate that success with its necessary preparation.
